The following lists are suggestions, and would need to be varied depending on the needs of the learner in question. Many learners would benefit from a visual timetable, task tick sheets and a homework diary alongside these items.

- Hundred square
- Blank or filled number line
- 24 hour clock
- Images and diagrams explaining key concepts
- Lists or formulae or rules
- Dry wipe marker and small white board
- Task vocabulary cards
- Examples of worked questions

Science study pack

- Periodic table
- Vocabulary cards
- Diagrams and/or flow charts explaining key processes
- Science report writing frame
- Study guide and/or mind map for current area of study
- Key mnemonics for remembering ideas such as 'King Phillip's Children Ordered Fries, Gravy, and Shakes' for Kingdom, Phylum, Class, Order, Family, Genus, Species

English study pack

- Sound button or Dictaphone
- Spelling journal
- Alphabet/sound chart
- Mnemonics for spelling
- Study guide for class text
- Dry wipe marker and small white board
- Blank writing frames for different genres
- Dictionary/thesaurus
- Reading ruler

History study pack

- Time line for period of study
- Character cards for people being studied
- T charts comparing lives of different sections of society
- Key dates memory cards
- Images and photos of costume, characters and buildings from relevant period
- Study guide or mind map for current period
- Key mnemonics
